



Unconscious

- **ABCDE** (*airway, breathing, circulation, disability, evaluation*)
- **Oxygen**
- **Cervical Precautions**
- **Transfer to Hospital Emergently**


Regaining Consciousness

- MD's Action Based on Circumstances
- Evaluate C-spine
 - motor function
 - cervical vertebrae tenderness
- Recovered responses rational (full motor control, no C-spine tenderness)
- Sit on canvas move to stool (assistance)

Regained Consciousness Evaluation (continued)

- Neurological Evaluation
- Observe pupils, (PERRL) EOMI
- Gait, Balance
- Exam repeated until normal
- LOC < 1 minute (clinical judgement)
- LOC > 1 minute (transfer to hospital)

Eye Movement Pathways



- Major cortical areas involved in control of eye movements and visual processing, with projections illustrating saccade generation in black.

Transfer to Hospital

- **Vision Changes** (*pupils different size, decreased vision, eyelid drooping, uncontrollable eye movements*)
- **Nausea, Vomiting**
- **Change in Level of Consciousness** (*apathetic, lethargic, sleepy, stuporous, unconscious*)
- **Sudden Headache**
- **Neurologic Changes** (*weakness, confusion, seizure, difficulty speaking or understanding speech, parasthesias, change in motor function, irritability*)

Medication

- No NSAIDS (bleeding predisposition)
- No Narcotics, Benzodiazepines, or other sedative medication

Aequanimitas

- Having an Even Mind

“a state of psychological stability and composure which is undisturbed by the experience of exposure to emotions, or other phenomena that may cause others to lose the balance of their mind”
